

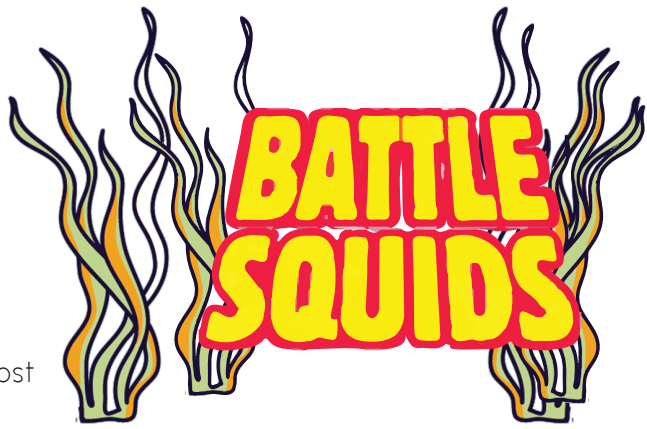

Do you have a situation where you don't know what to do? Write about it. Ask God to give you the wisdom you need to do the right thing.

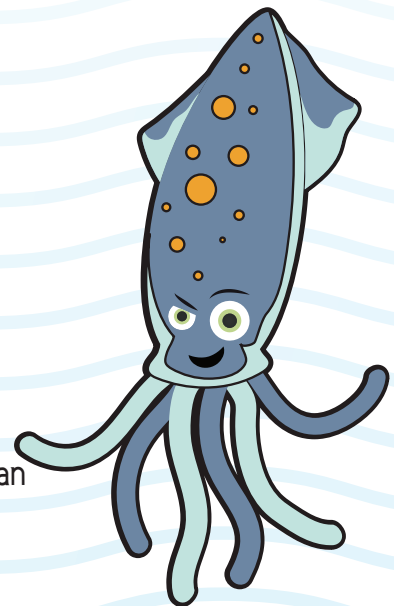
## This week we learned
